Are electric cars the path to a cleaner, greener future?

The left has been selling this for a long time. And, in interest of full disclosure, I drive a Prius, which is a petro-electric hybrid. Gets 44 mpg overall, and with a 10 gallon tank, my fill-ups used to be around \$20. But it is not a plug in, and this story is about those cars you need to plug into the grid to charge the battery.

So the question is: Are electric cars going to save the earth? I am indebted to Larry Alton, who wrote or researched much of the information presented here.

The pro-electric crowd points to the pollution-free running of electrics. But we need to ask, where does the electricity come from? When the answer is coal, the gain is not so clear. Sourcing electricity from coal causes 4 times more pollution related deaths than gas. In addition to that, the processes required to make battery driven cars is more polluting than that of petro-cars. Making the batteries requires higher polluting processes and materials (like lithium).

And then there is the question of what will we do with hundreds of millions of batteries that have run out of life. These are very toxic, and cannot be disposed of by merely dumping them in a landfill. There is no good technology for safe disposal.

Electric cars are catching fire, and the fire from a battery is both highly toxic and very violent. It would be bad enough outside, but if your car burns while in your garage, your whole house will be gone in minutes. There are lots of videos on the internet showing EVs catching fire.

And lastly, it takes 75 kWh (75,000 Watts) to charge one car. Two cars will take 150 kWh. By contrast, charging your phone takes 5 watts. If every house is trying to charge two cars overnight, the drain on the grid will be enormous.

The idea of EVs is enticing, but the technologies are still not mature.
