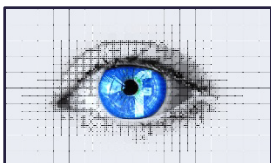
None will want to leave their home, even if they could. All our attention would be on preserving what little we have left from starving people looking to take what they can from you.
